

**Date:** Saturday, September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2018

Site: Shepherd High School Cross Country Course

Meet Format: There will be 1 race for each Varsity gender and for Team Placing and Trophies split into 2 divisions. Medals will be awarded per race and not split by division.

## Awards: 1. Trophies to top 2 teams in each division – Trophies can be picked up at Finish Table once results posted

- 2. 50 medals in each HS Varsity race, 30 medals in each MS race Awarded in Chute
- 3. Varsity Team Champion Shirts for Winning Team in each Division (7 Shirts per team) Picked up with Trophy
- 4. Top 10 T-shirts to Top 10 finishers in each HS Varsity and MS race Awarded in Chute

**Course:** The races will be held on Shepherd Public School's Cross Country course. The course is extremely spectator and runner friendly. It is a one loop course with a mix of paths through fields as well as trails so wooded areas. With a relatively small amount of movement spectators and coaches can see athletes 5-6 times and someone wanting to run a little bit can probably catch them 8 times. (See Attached Map)

**Timing:** Athletes will be assigned a shoe chip tag that must be returned and a matching bib. The chips will come in an envelope and coaches must return envelope with all chips or school will be charged \$30 per missing chip. Athletes will lace chips in their shoe laces.

**Packet Pick Up:** Coaches may pick up their packet with bibs and chips at the Pole Barn from 7:30 AM to 11:30 AM. Coaches may drop off collected chip envelope to the Finish Line. (See Attached Map)

Cost: \$200 total for both HS genders (\$100 if only bringing one), \$70 for MS team

Spectator Admission: \$5 for Adults. Kids 8 and under are free

Athlete Drop Off / Bus Parking: Busses may drop athletes off at Entrance #2 then park (See Attached Map) Busses should park in Parking Lot #6, the Shepherd Public School Bus Loop. (See Attached Map)

**Spectator Parking:** Spectators may park in Parking Lot #1, #2, #3 and then #4 or #5 if necessary. (See Attached Map)

**Shirts/Concession:** 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Bluejay Invite Shirts will be available & basic concessions including donuts and coffee in the morning with hot dogs later in the day. Chips, Candy, Muffins, Powerade & Water available all day.

Entries: All entries will be made online at http://www.athletic.net. Entries due Wednesday September 26<sup>th</sup> at 8 PM.
